## Father's Column

### **A Short Explanation of the Five First Saturdays** ~ From [fatima.org](http://fatima.org)

On December 10, 1925, our Loving Mother Mary, appearing to Lucy, the only survivor of those who saw our Lady at Fatima, spoke these heart-rending words: "My child, behold My Heart surrounded with the thorns which ungrateful men place therein at every moment by their blasphemies and ingratitude. You, at least, try to console Me. Announce in My name that I promise to assist at the hour of death, all those who, on the first Saturday of five consecutive months, shall:

- Go to confession and receive Holy Communion,
- Recite the Rosary,
- And keep Me company for a quarter of an hour while meditating on the 15 mysteries of the Rosary,
- With the intention of making reparation to Me.



I promise to assist them at the hour of their death with all the graces necessary to save their souls." N.B. The Confession may be made during the eight days before or after the Communion. The Rosary (five decades) may be recited at any convenient time of the day, and the 15- minute meditation may be made at any time of the day, either on all the mysteries as a whole, or on one special mystery.

### **WHY FIVE?**

When Sister Lucy, in prayer, asked our Lord why five Saturdays, He answered: "My daughter, the reason is simple. There are five types of offenses and blasphemies committed against the Immaculate Heart of Mary:

- Blasphemies against the Immaculate Conception
- Blasphemies against Her Virginity.
- Blasphemies against Her Divine Maternity, in refusing at the same time to recognize Her as the Mother of men.
- The blasphemies of those who publicly seek to sow in the hearts of children indifference or scorn, or even hatred of this Immaculate Mother.
- The offenses of those who outrage Her directly in Her Holy Images.
