Father Barone's Column

The Early Church on the Mass as Sacrifice

A major theological difference between Catholics and Protestants is whether Christ intended to give His Church a ritual sacrifice. Many Protestants believe that because Christ was sacrificed 2,000 years ago, any attempt to “re-sacrifice” Christ would be blasphemous. As Catholics, we do not “re-sacrifice” Christ, but rather offer and enter into His one eternal sacrifice. The early Church universally regarded the Mass as a sacrifice as is evidenced by the following:

The Didache (70AD): “Assemble on the Lord’s day, and break bread and offer the Eucharist; but first make confession of your faults, so that your sacrifice may be a pure one. Anyone who has a difference with his fellow is not to take part with you until he has been reconciled, so as to avoid any profanation of your sacrifice.”

Pope St. Clement I (80AD or 95AD): “Our sin will not be small if we eject from the episcopate those who blamelessly and holily have offered its sacrifices.”

St. Ignatius of Antioch (107AD): “Make certain, therefore, that you all observe one common Eucharist; for there is but one Body of our Lord Jesus Christ, and but one cup of union with his Blood, and one single altar of sacrifice—even as there is also but one bishop, with his clergy and my own fellow servitors, the deacons.”

St. Justin Martyr (155AD): “[God] then speaks of those Gentiles, namely us [Christians] who in every place offer sacrifices to him, that is, the bread of the Eucharist and also the cup of the Eucharist.”

St. Cyprian of Carthage (253AD): “If Christ Jesus, our Lord and God, is himself the high priest of God the Father; and if he offered himself as a sacrifice to the Father; and if he commanded that this be done in commemoration of himself, then certainly the priest, who imitates that which Christ did, truly functions in place of Christ.”

St. John Chrysostom (387AD): “When you see the Lord immolated and lying upon the altar, and the priest bent over that sacrifice praying, and all the people empurpled by that precious blood, can you think that you are still among men and on earth? Or are you not lifted up to heaven?”
